I. God's Expectations – James 3:13-18	
> [1] God wants peace – "first of all pure then peaceable"	
> [2] In opposition to this is the world, flesh & devil	
II. God's Assessment – James 4:1-10	
> [1] You are being controlled by the flesh – 4:1-3 – not the Spirit	
✓ This must end or there will be tension, warfare & death	
> [2] You are being controlled by the world – 4:4-6 – not heaven	
✓ The world brings enmity with man; it also does so with God > [3] You are being controlled by the devil – 4:7-10 – not God	
✓ {1} Negatively – "Resist the devil" – 4:7	
✓ {2} Positively – "Draw Nigh to God" – 4:8-10



What's the connection between 4:1-10 & 4:11-12?	
Notice the Development of the Argument	
► {1} He Presents the Principle – 4:1-10 ► [1] The Need to Confront the Flesh & its Lust – 4:1-3	
> [2] The Need to Confront the World & its Impact – 4:4-6 > [3] The Need to Confront the Devil & his Influence– 4:7-10	
> {2} He Presents the Application – 4:11-12	
He Presents the Practical Outworking of that Principle in Every Day Life	
✓ The World, the Flesh & the Devil strongly influence our personal standards and judgment of each other.

1A. The Command – 4:11 – "stop speaking against one another"	
What Creates So Much Division? > Why Do So Many Tensions Exist?	
➢ It's Tied Up in the Greek Word – καταλαλέω –	
'katalaleō' (4x in vv. 11-12) ➤ It means literally —	
'to speak' (laleō) + 'down on' (kata)	
➤ When we go beyond Scripture (when Scripture is no longer the sole standard)	
 ▶ Then we set ourselves up as the standard ▶ & from that lofty standpoint – 	
we ' <u>speak down</u> ' on others	-

James 4:11-12	,
1A. The Command – 4:11 "Stop speaking down on/against one another"	
➤ What is the Problem With Our Standards of Judgment?	
➤ [1] They're Influenced by the Flesh/Our Personal Desires ➤ That's where all our fights come from – 4:1-3	
> [2] They're Influenced by the World/Worldly Values	
➤ That's the cause of enmity with man & God – 4:4-6	
 ▶ [3] They're Influenced by the Devil/They're demonic ▶ That's rooted in the influence of the devil - 4:7-10 	
> That's what makes our opinions so dangerous

➤ [1] One who speaks down on his brother judges his brother		
> [2] One then speaks down on what is by quality law of God		
> [3] One thus 'judges' that which is by quality law of God		
2C. The Result		
➤ [1] You are not 'by quality' a 'doer of the law'		
➤ [2] You are 'by quality' a 'judge of the law'		





Just Meditate on This for a Moment ➤ When We 'Thus' Set Ourselves Above Others & Speak Down on them ➤ We Set Ourselves Above the 'Law of God' ➤ And we 'speak' (laleō) + 'down' (kata) on it [God's Word] as well ➤ & When We Put Ourselves Above God's Word & 'thus' 'speak' 'down' on it ➤ We put ourselves on a level with God Himself ➤ Which is most preposterous ➤ It is the Ultimate Evidence of Human Arrogance
