The word "brethren"/"brothers" is found 3 times in these 5 verses

2A. What is the Emphasis of the Passage? -5:1-11

- 1B. The Lord is Coming
 - \triangleright [1] v 3 "it is in the last days"
 - > [2] v 7a "Be patient until the coming of the Lord"
 - > [3] v. 8 "the coming of the Lord is at hand"
 - ➤ [4] v. 9 "the Judge is standing right at the door"

2B. We are to be Patient

There are two related words that stand out because of their use in these verses.

- ↓ {1} makrothumia makro (long) thum (tempered) ia
- ¥ {2} hupomenō menō (remain) hupo (under)
- 3B. We are to Stand Firm in Patience $5:8 st\bar{e}riksate$ ($\sigma \tau \eta \rho i \xi \alpha \tau \varepsilon$) no place for doubt

If we fail to depend on God

- ♣ {1} We exchange the value system of the Bible for the value system of the world
- 4 {2} We exchange a dependence on God for a dependence on worldly wealth

We get so tied up with the world's value system, but the world's value system is rotten.

- ❖ (1) Their standards/values are bad/rotten 4:2-3
 - 3 areas around which their life is built & 3 verbs that describe each.
 - ↓ [1] riches sesēpen [σέσηπεν] "stand rotted" no value

PEOPLE

- **↓** [2] clothes − gegonen [yέγονεν] − "stand mother eaten"
- ↓ [3] silver & gold corrode not rust *katiōtai kata* emphatic rusted out.
- ❖ (2) Their outlook is equally bad/rotten v 1 miseries coming

Why is their outlook so bad? Because God is going to judge them. And why is He going to judge them?

- + [1] for cheating -5:4
- **↓** [2] for comfortable living at the expense of others 5:5
- **↓** [3] for condemning others 5:6
- ❖ (3) Their condition is bad/rotten "you have fattened your hearts" 5:5
